### TEST CYCLE 2018 – Sat., May 19, police candidates



Announcing that May 19, 2018 has been selected for the test cycle to be conducted at **Southwestern Illinois College**, Belleville, IL for potential police candidates. Eligibility requirement details and Application materials are available on the web site.

By testing with us, you may be eligible to appear on an eligibility list for **ELEVEN DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS**, depending upon your qualifications and examination scores.

- Minimum educational requirements: A minimum of 60-64 semester credit hours toward a Bachelor's degree; an Associate's degree; a Bachelor's degree – if expected by the end of the Fall Semester 2019, you will be eligible for this test cycle.
- In lieu of education requirement, you must possess: a current certification from another law enforcement agency or accredited law enforcement training center); or 2 - 4 years full time law enforcement experience with a municipal, county, state or federal agency (or military police); or 24/36 months of active duty in the US Armed Forces OR have served 180 days of active duty in the US Armed Forces in combat duty recognized by the Dept. of Defense.
