**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR THE USE AND  
STORAGE OF RESIDENTIAL REFUSE CONTAINERS IN THE  
CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, ILLINOIS**

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**NOW, THEREFORE,** BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE as follows:

**Section 1:** Chapter 9.24.070 (Reserved) of Title 9 (Public Peace, Morals, and Welfare) of the Collinsville Municipal Code, is hereby amended by the addition of two Sections, to be read in their entirety as follows:

**“Sec. 9.24.070 – Outdoor Storage of Residential Refuse Containers.**

- A. All residential refuse or recycling containers, when not in a completely enclosed building, shall not be located in front of the front building line of the primary structure. In the case of a corner lot, the dwelling shall be considered to have two (2) fronts and the determination of side versus rear of the structure shall be by prevailing yard patterns in the block. In the case of a "through lot or double frontage lot" as defined in section 17.020.020 of the City's Municipal Code, front versus rear will be determined by prevailing yard patterns. In cases where there are unique circumstances stances, such as an irregular shaped lot or an existing landscaping screen, the storage of residential refuse containers may be reviewed and approved by the City.
- B. Time Restrictions. Except as provided below, refuse containers shall not be set at curbside earlier than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the scheduled pick up day. Refuse containers shall be removed from the curbside and returned to a location permitted by section 9.24.070 A this Chapter as quickly as possible after pick up, but not later than twenty-four (24) hours following the scheduled pick up day.”

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

**SECTION 3.** Nothing contained herein shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant or otherwise nullify any other ordinance of the City or the requirements thereof whether or not relating to or in any manner connected with the subject matter hereof, unless expressly set forth herein.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication according to law.




